Wednesday Bird Walks at the Wetlands

Sweetwater Wetlands Park

8:30 a.m. every Wednesday, September – May

What: Discover the rich diversity of birds (and maybe some rarities!) at north-central Florida's newest birding hotspot in a 2-3-hour walking tour. Birders of all levels welcome. Bring binoculars.

Where: Sweetwater Wetlands Park, on the south side of Gainesville, 3/4 mile east of the intersection of SW 13th Street/US 441 and Williston Road. Look for the sign on the south side of the road. We'll meet at the covered shelter by the parking lot.

When: Every Wednesday from September - May, at 8:30 a.m.

Who: Birding Field Trips will be led by volunteers from Alachua Audubon Society.

How much? Walks are free, but park admission is \$5/car.
